1062.01 INJURY TO PARK PROPERTY.

No person shall obstruct any walk or drive in any public park or playground and no person shall injure, mar or damage in any manner any monument, ornament, fence, bridge, seat, tree, fountain, shrub, flower, playground equipment, fireplace or other public property within or pertaining to a public park or playground.

1062.02 INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

No person shall bring into or drink in any public park any alcoholic beverage.

1062.03 USE OF WASTE CONTAINERS.

No person shall place or deposit any garbage, glass, tin cans, paper or miscellaneous waste in any park or playground except in containers provided for that purpose.

1062.04 BALL GAMES.

No person shall engage in baseball, football or softball throwing, or other violent or rough exercises, or play in any public park or other public place, except in areas designated therefor by order of Council.

1062.05 ADDITIONAL RULES.

Council may, by resolution, prescribe additional rules and regulations pertaining to the conduct and use of parks and public grounds as it shall deem necessary to administer the same and to protect public property and the safety, health, morals and welfare of the public, and no person shall fail to comply with such rules and regulations.
