220.01 REGULAR MEETINGS.

Until otherwise provided, regular meetings of the Litchfield City Council shall be held in the established Council Chambers in the City Hall on the third Tuesday of each calendar month, commencing at 6:30 p.m.

220.02 ELECTIONS; TERMS OF OFFICE.

(a) The terms of office for the two Councilmen, due to expire as provided by the City Charter on the second Monday in March, 1971, are hereby altered so as to expire on the second Monday in November, 1971.

(b) The terms of office for the two Councilmen, due to expire as provided by the City Charter on the second Monday in March, 1972, are hereby altered as follows:

- (1) The term of office for the Councilman receiving the lessor number of votes in the last regular Municipal election at which he or she was elected is hereby altered so as to expire on the second Monday in November, 1971.
- (2) The term of office for the Councilman receiving the greater number of votes in the last regular Municipal election at which he or she was elected to office is hereby altered so as to expire on the second Monday in November, 1973.

(c) The terms of office for the two Councilmen, due to expire as provided by the City Charter on the second Monday in March, 1973, are hereby altered so as to expire on the second Monday in November, 1973. (Ord. 1971-2. Passed 2-23-71.)

(d) Three Councilmen shall be elected at the odd-numbered year election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1971, and at the regularly scheduled odd-numbered year elections following, at four-year intervals thereafter.

(e) Three Councilmen shall be elected at the odd-numbered year election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1973, and at the regularly scheduled odd-numbered year elections following, at four-year intervals, thereafter.
