TIFA Regular Meeting Minutes

July 8, 2020

Call to order

Chairman Ed Smith called to order the regular meeting of the Litchfield TIFA at 7:00 p.m. on July 8, 2020 in Litchfield City Hall. (This meeting was held by Phone Conference due to the Covid-19 Pandemic)

Merit Fiber Optic Discussion: Jim Moran of Merit presented the TIFA Board with a mission and purpose statement related to Merit helping to sponsor and coordinate the development of fiber optics within the industrial park and city. Brendan Sanger asked about costs. Mr. Moran stated that it would cost approximately \$70,000 to tap and install fiber optic to the LRTC Building from there it would have to be distributed throughout the industrial park. Mr. Moran also stated that we would have to enter into an agreement with a company named Challenger to actually complete the physical installation. Mr. Moran also stated that many communities use a company named Aspen which completes the design and installation to the individual businesses and residents wanting to hook-up. Mr. Moran suggested that the TIFA Board delay making a decision committing to this project until further discussions can be held with Aspen Wireless.
