222.01 ELECTION; TERM OF OFFICE.

(a) The term of office for the Mayor, due to expire as provided by the City Charter on the second Monday in March, 1973, is hereby altered so as to expire on the second Monday in November, 1973.

(b) The Mayor shall henceforth be elected at the even-numbered year election, with the change to take effect as provided in MCL 168.642a (4), thereby resulting in the regular city election that would have been held in November, 2019 being held in November, 2020, and the regular city election that would have been held in November, 2021 being held in November, 2022, with the terms of the Mayor whose term would have otherwise expired as of the applicable regular odd-year elections in 2019 and 2021 being extended until the holding of the next regular even-year elections in 2020 and 2022, respectively.
