410.01 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE ADOPTED BY REFERENCE.

The Michigan Vehicle Code, M.C.L.A. 257.1 through 257.923, as amended and specifically including Section 257.625(1)(c) thereof and all future amendments and revisions to the Michigan Vehicle Code when they are in this state are incorporated and adopted by reference. (Ord. 2003-12. Passed 11-10-03; Ord. 2012-01. Passed 5-8-12.)

410.02 ENFORCEMENT.

The purpose of the Michigan Vehicle Code is to regulate the operation of vehicles, to provide for the regulation and use of streets, highways, and alleys, and other public and semi-public places within the City, and to provide penalties for the violation of the vehicle code.

(See) The City shall not enforce any provisions of the Michigan Vehicle Code adopted by reference herein where a violation of the provision constitutes a felony or where a violation of the provision constitutes a misdemeanor with a maximum period of imprisonment greater than 93 days, except that a violation of Section 625(1)(c) of the Michigan Vehicle Code, 1949 PA 300, M.C.L.A. 257.625, shall be punishable by one or more of the following:

- (i) Community service for not more than 90 days.
 - (ii) Imprisonment for not more than 180 days.
 - (iii) A fine of not less than \$200 or more than \$700.
