PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2024**

To the qualified electors of THE CITIES of Hillsdale, Jonesville, Litchfield and Reading and, THE TOWNSHIPS of Adams, Allen, Amboy, Cambria, Camden, Fayette, Hillsdale, Jefferson, Litchfield, Moscow, Pittsford, Ransom, Reading, Scipio, Somerset, Wheatland, Woodbridge and Wright in THE COUNTY OF HILLSDALE, STATE OF MICHIGAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the above mentioned Townships or Cities who are not already registered, may register to vote at the office of their respective Township or City Clerk, the office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agencies. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township or City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, July 22, 2024**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at their Township or City Clerk’s office during regular business hours, special pre-election weekend hours, or on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., as follows:
